Event Licence Application

Sligo Airport would like to give notice of its intent to apply to Sligo County Council within the next two weeks for a licence to hold an outdoor event in accordance with part XVI of the Planning and Development act 2000 (as amended), and the Planning and Development (amended) Regulations 2000.

The event will be a 2-day airshow that includes international and national flight display and parachute teams alongside ground activities including, a funfair, food and craft market. The Air Display will consist of a fully programmed event on Saturday 27th July, 15:00-21:30 and Sunday 28th July 2024, 11:00-17:30, Admission to the event will be ticketed to the public and is expected to attract approximately 10,000 people over the 2 days (2,000 Saturday & 8,000 Sunday) with attendees consisting mainly of families from the community and tourists. Special event paid parking areas have been identified, with the addition of a park and Ride in operation on the Sunday from Sligo Town.

The licence application may be inspected at the Offices of Sligo County Council during office hours for a period of five weeks from the date of receipt of the application by Sligo County Council. Any submissions or observations may be made to Sligo County Council within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of the application.
