Appendix G – Adventure Providers User Agreement

Wild Roots Music Performing Arts and Adventure Festival adventure providers user agreement.

- All adventure providers must provide NOC Shop Ltd. and The Wild Roots Music Performing Arts and Adventure festival with a letter of indemnity for all activities they are providing.
- All personnel working for or with the adventure provider must be Garda Vetted.
- All personnel working for or with the adventure providers must adhere to all Wild Roots Festival health and safety procedures and COVID risk mitigation measures.

The outdoor adventure activity providers bringing people out on Lough Gill will access the water at Anna Bay, Hazelwood Co. Sligo point C. There will be access to the water here for launching.

- All equipment stand up paddle boards, kayaks, paddles etc. used at this area **must** be washed down before and after use in this area, in a manner which will prevent the spread of invasive species such as zebra mussels.
- All Water based activities must avoid the shallow lake edge areas, particularly vegetated areas such as reed beds.
- All festival attendees must be provided with safety equipment such as life jackets that are fit for purpose.
- All equipment must be sanitised between uses.
- All festival attendees must have a safety briefing and demonstration before going out on the water with the tour operator.
- Appropriate safety ratios of instructor to students on the water must be adhered to for each activity.
